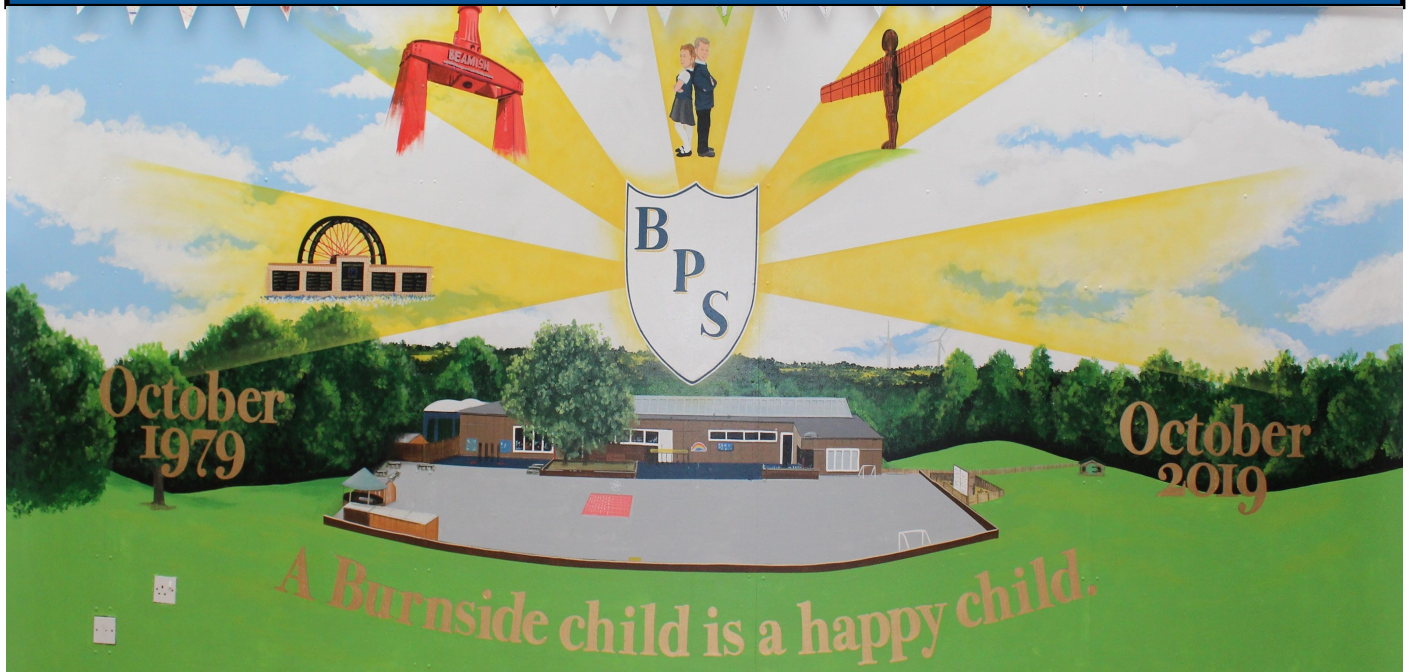

It is an expectation that all children in our school complete homework at home on a weekly basis. Please support your child to achieve this!



Remote Learning

The Government expects all schools to have a Remote Learning offer in place by the end of September in order to ensure that children who are absent from school continue to learn and are exposed to the same curriculum as their peers in school. Parents and carers will shortly be receiving a Home School Agreement with regards our new Google Classroom. Class teachers will be uploading work onto this area weekly in order to facilitate home learning for children who are isolating. Our expectation is that all children who are absent from school for more than two days, and are well enough to do so, begin accessing the Google Classroom. Children should communicate with their adults in class regularly and complete work in English, Maths and one other subject daily.
